Attendance! Attendance! Attendance!

The first half term at Ysgol Uwchradd Bodedern has been an exciting one, full of activities. From STEM activities for year 9 to extracurricular trips and revision activities for year 11. A big thank you to all who attended and to you as parents for your continued support.

In order to get the most from these experiences and to take advantage of the support we offer, we ask that pupils attend school as much as possible.

Our school's target for attendance is 100%. We understand that attending school may be difficult at times due to illness, which is a natural occurrence amongst young people, but long-term absences can be damaging to an individual's education and mental health.

We have just had 8 weeks of school during the last half term, which is 39 school days. Missing 4 days or 24 lessons equates to missing 10% of school, which has a serious impact on the education of our young people. This will also present further challenges when pupils have to catch up on any work that has been missed.

However! Remember that help is available and please contact the head of year to discuss any concerns you may have regarding your child's absences.
