Attendance

Attendance is a whole school focus and is paramount for any child's success. Pupils achieve when they attend lessons, therefore must attend school.

Attending school is statutory until the end of year 11. Our target for your child is to attend every day. If they are ill, it's important that as a parent / guardian that you contact the school to let us know why your child is absent and when they'll be returning. Support is available from our pastoral team and Educational Welfare Officer.

There are some changes to our pastoral team this year and the ones supporting your child as head of year.

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School uniform
