



# Diweddariad 09/09 Update

## I SYLW Rhieni, Gwarcheidwaid a Disgyblion Ysgol Uwchradd Bodedern

Pleser fory fydd estyn croeso i flwyddyn 8 yn ôl, ac yna bydd ein holl ddisgyblion wedi dychwelyd atom. Yn gyntaf hoffwn ddiolch i chi gyd am eich cymorth a'ch cydweithrediad ac i'r holl staff am yr holl waith paratoi.

Mae'r disgyblion wedi bod yn wych ac yn prysur dod i arfer efo'r trefniadau newydd. Fel y gwyddoch, mae gennym barthau diogel ac ond disgyblion blynyddoedd penodol sydd yn y parthau hynny.

Rydym hefyd wedi gallu lleihau y nifer o ddisgyblion sy'n gorfod ciwio am ginio drwy osod sustem archerbu newydd ar lein.

Rydym eisoes yn argymhell yn gryf y dylid eu defnyddio gan blant a phobol ifanc dros 11 oed sy'n defnyddio cludiant dynodedig o'r cartref i'r ysgol.”

Felly er bod di-heintyddion dwylo ymhob ystafell, a bod bob blwyddyn mewn parth diogel, rydym yn ystyried gorchudd wyneb fel mesur lleihau risg ychwanegol. **Felly hoffwn bwysleisio y byddwn yn dymuno i bob disgybl a staff wisgo gorchudd wyneb wrth symud o un dosbarth i'r llall neu symud i'r man bwyta cinio.** Dewis personol fydd gwisgo masg mewn gwersi.

## Diweddariad 09/09 Update

### **FOR THE ATTENTION OF Parents, Guardians and Ysgol Uwchradd Bodedern Pupils**

*It will be a pleasure tomorrow to welcome back year 8, and then all the pupils will have returned to school. I would like to thank you all for your help and co-operation and all the staff for all their hard work in ensuring a safe and enjoyable return.*

*The pupils have been fantastic and are getting used to the new arrangements. As you know, we have safe zones and only those pupils of certain years are in those zones.*

*We have also been able to reduce the number of pupils who have to queue for lunch by introducing a new online booking system for pupils in year 10 and 11.*

*As you know, it is compulsory for all pupils to wear a face covering on all school buses, and before every bus leaves school we check and hand out masks free of charge to any pupil who does not have a mask.*

*When it comes to wearing a face cover at school I noted the following in my previous update:*

*“The Isle of Anglesey County Council continues to work closely with schools to ensure they are as safe and Covid secure as possible when learners return next week. In light of the World Health Organisation’s recent announcement and the Welsh Government Chief Medical Officer’s advice, we strongly recommended the use of face coverings where social distancing cannot be maintained in secondary schools (e.g. situations where physical distancing between contact groups is difficult to maintain) as an additional risk-reducing measure. We already strongly recommend their use by children and young people above the age of 11, who use designated home-to-school transport.”*

*Therefore, although there are hand sanitisers in every room, and every year are in a safe zone, we consider face covering as an additional risk reduction measure, **so I would like to emphasise that we would like all pupils and staff to wear a face covering when moving from one class to another or when walking to the dining area.** It is a personal choice to wear a mask in lessons.*

*I would like to thank all the pupils for their support and willingness to adapt, it is great to see and meet them. I know that we will also receive their support in wearing masks on the bus and between lessons. And I thank you in advance for your support on this matter.*
