Dylai pob disgyl Blwyddyn 7 -11 wisgo:

- Tei ysgol – streipen goch a nefi** (maent i'w cael yn yr ysgol neu'r siopau).
- Siwmper wedi ei gweu nefi blw gyda gwddw V a logo'r ysgol.**
Mae'r ysgol yn hyrwyddo Look Around Sport, Brodwaith, Orchid Fashion a Rapsaliwn fel ein prif ddarparwyr
- Blows / Crys coch plaen, gyda cholera llewys hir** (neu llewys byr yn yr haf - nid crys "polo")

Mae gwisg wahanol ar gyfer disgylion blwyddyn 12 a 13: siwmper gwddw V mewn glas tywyll gyda log y 6ed dosbarth a chrys gwyn.

Bechgyn a Merched

- Trowsus – du o hyd a lled cyffredin (dim jins, cords, denim na chinos).
- Os belt, belt du plaen.
- (Gall merched wisgo pe dymunir sgert at y benglin nefi neu ddu)
- Sanau plaen du (neu deits du i ferched pe dymunir)

Addysg Gorfforol:

- Esgidiau Campfa (*Trainers*) gyda gwadnau golau;
- Llodrau / shorts du neu 'navy'; Sanau pêl-droed coch; Crys T coch a peiping glas
- Crys rygbi cildroadwy

Os dymunir: Esgidiau pêl-droed; Coesarn ar gyfer pêl-droed



Am resymau lechyd a Diogelwch, ac i arbed trafferth a drwgdeimlad gyda cholledion ni chaniateir i ddisgyblion wisgo:

- (i) tlysau ee mwclis. breichled (ag eithrio oriawr)
- (ii) modrwyau

Caniateir i ddisgyblion wisgo **un clustdlws “stud” yn unig ymhob clust.**

- Dylid gwisgo esgidiau du plaen sawdl isel sy'n addas a diogel ar gyfer diwrnod ysgol.**
Ni chaniateir esgidiau platfform uchel na sodlau uchel (dim uwch na 4 cm), na thrainers, na "boots" megis "UGGS" na sandalau – nid yw eu hedrychiad yn gweddu â gweddill y wisg ysgol. Ni chaniateir gwisgo motifau na bathodynnau.
- Argymhellir cotiau rhad, plaen tywyll.**
Ni chaniateir gwisgo siacedi denim na 'hoodies' ac mae angen bod yn ofalus iawn wrth ddewis côt law. Dylid osgoi'r dewis o liwiau llachar a chotiau/anoracau gyda motifau ffasiynol. Ni chaniateir gwisgo côt, sgarff na phenwysg y tu mewn i'r adeilad.
- Yn ogystal â'r eitemau a restrir, **disgwyli'r i ymddangosiad cyffredinol pob disgyl a myfyriwr fod yn dderbyniol i'r Pennaeth.** Ni ddylid lliwio gwallt na'i dorri mewn steil eithafol na gwisgo colur. Ni chaniateir addurniadau yn y gwallt e.e. blodau.
- Dylai'r bag ysgol fod yn addas i gario ffeiliau, llyfrau a dillad ar gyfer addysg gorfforol (neu gellir cael bag arall addas ar gyfer addysg gorfforol).
- Dylai pob eiddo personol fod wedi ei farcio'n glir ag enw llawn y perchennog.

YSGOL UWCHRADD BODEDERN Year 7 – 11 PUPILS RULES CONCERNING PUPILS' UNIFORM AND APPEARANCE

Every pupil in years 7 -11 should wear:

- School tie - red and navy stripes (available at the school or shops)**
- A knitted navy blue v-neck jumper with official logo. The school promotes Look Around Sport, Brodwaith and Orchid Fashion, a Rapscaiwn as our main suppliers**
- Blouse / Shirt - plain red with collar and long sleeves (short sleeve in summer – not a 'polo' shirt)**

The uniform for year 12 and 13 is slightly different: v neck navy blue jumper with the 6th form logo and white shirt.



Boys and Girls:

- Trousers - black of conventional length and width (not jeans, cords, denims, chinos).**
- If a belt is worn it must be plain black**
- Girls are permitted to wear a navy/black knee length skirt if desired)**
- Plain black or navy socks (or black/navy tights for girls if desired).**

Physical Education

- Trainers (no black soles);**
- Plain black or navy shorts; Red football socks; Red T shirt and blue piping;**
- Convertible Rugby shirt with navy stripe;**
- Optional: Football Boots; Shin pads for football**

For Health and Safety reasons, and to avoid the problems that inevitably arise when losses occur pupils are prohibited from wearing

- (i) Jewellery e.g. necklaces, bangles (except watches)
- (ii) Rings

Pupils are permitted to wear one "stud" in each ear only.

- SHOES – low-heeled, plain black shoes which are suitable and safe for school should be worn. Platform soles, high heeled shoes (heels must be no higher than 4 cm), trainers, boots e.g. "UGGS" and sandals are not allowed – as they detract from the appearance of the school uniform. No badges or insignia other than official school badges may be worn with school uniform.**
- COATS - Cheap, dark, plain coats are recommended. Denim jackets and hoodies are not allowed. It is important to choose a raincoat or anorak carefully to avoid glaring colours and fashionable motifs. No coats, scarves or headgear to be worn inside the building.**
- In addition to the items specified, the appearance of pupils must be acceptable to the Head teacher. Hair should not be artificially coloured or styled/ cut in an extreme fashion and the wearing of make-up is prohibited. Hair accessories e.g. flowers are not allowed.**
- A school bag suitable for carrying files, books and sports clothing should be used (or an additional suitable bag could be used for carrying sports clothing)**
- All personal possessions should be clearly marked with the owner's full name**
