Beth fydd a i'n ddysgu?

Bydd y cwrs hwn yn eich helpu chi i wella eich iechyd, ffitrwydd a'ch gallu corfforol yn yr ysgol. Byddwch hefyd yn dysgu am agweddau theori y pwnc gan gynnwys Ffisioleg, Seicoleg a Chymdeithaseg.

Sut fydd a i'n dysgu?

Mae'r cwrs wedi'i seilio ar wersi theori, ymarferol ac hefyd gwersi sy'n cysylltu'r theori gyda'r ymarferol.

Beth fydd a ei angen?

Byddwch angen offer cyflawn bob tro, h.y. ar gyfer gwersi ymarferol a theori. Yn ddibynol ar y gweithgaredd, weithiau bydd angen cit 2 a 3 gwaith mewn wythnos.

Sut fydd a i'n cael f'asesu?

- Ymarferol (50%)** – Asesir pob disgybl mewn sawl maes gwahanol gyda'r marc terfynol yn seiliedig ar dri gweithgaredd yn unig, prif weithgaredd gwerth 28% a dau arall gwerth 22%. Parhad o'r gwaith yn CA3 yw'r gwaith yma. Rhaid gwneud o leiaf un gweithgaredd tîm ac un unigol.
- Theori (50%)** – Disgwyllir i ddisgyblion ddilyn cwrs a asesir gan bapur arholiad 2 awr o hyd ar bump maes gwahanol: iechyd, ymarfer ac ymarfer corff, ffisioleg ymarfer corff, dadansoddi symud, seicoleg chwaraeon a materion diwylliannol-gymdeithasol mewn chwaraeon.

Beth sy'n digwydd ar ôl y cwrs hwn? Ar ôl Blwyddyn 11, gallwch astudio lefel A Addysg Gorfforol yn yr ysgol.

What will I learn?

This course will help you to improve your health, fitness and your practical ability in all sports taught at school. The course also takes in the theoretical factors which underpin performance including Psychology, Physiology and Sociology aspects.

How will I learn?

The course will be based on theoretical and practical lessons and also the application of the theory to the practical.

What will I need?

You will be required to come to lessons fully equipped at all times, for both the practical and the theoretical. Kit is essential and depending on the activity in question might be needed 2 or 3 times a week.

How will I be assessed?

- **Practical (50%)** – All pupils will be assessed in many activities with the final assessment based on three activities, one main activity worth 28%, and the other activities worth 22% each. These activities are a continuation of work done in KS3. You will have to fulfil one individual and one team activity.
- **Theory (50%)** - Pupils will follow a course of study, which is assessed by a written paper of 2 hours duration. There are five sections: Health, exercise and physical exercise, physiology of exercise, movement analysis, sports psychology, socio-cultural issues in sport.

What happens after this course?

After Year 11 you can study Physical Education A level at school.

Unit 9811 - Safety and security in construction - Construction activities take place in many different contexts. Through this unit, you will gain the knowledge and understanding to be able to plan how to minimise risk to their own and others health and safety in different contexts.

Unit 9812 - Practical construction skills - Through this unit you will be able to interpret technical information to plan the refurbishment of a building, taking account of health and safety issues. You will use appropriate skills and techniques to carry out the refurbishment.

Unit 9813 - Planning construction projects - You will use learning from the development of practical skills and health and safety requirements of construction processes and gain the knowledge and understanding needed to plan straightforward built environment development projects.

How will I learn?

Through practical and theory tasks.

What will I need?

A genuine interest in construction, problem solving skills, the ability to produce work to a high standard both practical and theory based. Working outside.

Yn Uned 2, byddwch chi'n cwblhau aseiniad lle byddwch chi'n cynllunio ac yn paratoi bwydlen mewn ymateb i friff. Bydd y project hwn yn werth 60% o'ch cymhwyster a bydd yn cymryd 12 awr.

What will I learn?

Unit 1: The Hospitality and Catering industry

You will:

- Learn about the hospitality and catering industry, the types of hospitality and catering providers and about working in the industry.
- Learn about health and safety, and food safety in hospitality and catering, as well as food related causes of ill health.

Unit 2: Hospitality and Catering in action

You will:

- Learn about the importance of nutrition and how cooking methods can impact on nutritional value.
- Learn how to plan nutritious menus as well as factors which affect menu planning. You will learn the skills and techniques needed to prepare, cook and present dishes as well as learning how to review your work effectively.

How will I learn?

- Master classes on kitchen designs.
- Visit different hospitality providers.
- Carry out practical activities based on workplace scenarios.
- Master classes on using preparation, cooking and presentation techniques.
- Carry out practical risk assessment activities based on workplace scenarios.

What will I need?

You will need to bring ingredients weekly to the practical lessons.

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed through a written examination and an assignment. Unit 1 will be assessed through an exam, which is worth 40% of your qualification. In Unit 2 you will complete an assignment where you will plan and prepare a menu in response to a brief. This will be worth 60% of your qualification and will take 12 hours.

What happens after this course?

By completing this course you will earn a Level 2 qualification equivalent to a GCSE.

What will I learn?

- All units will increase your understanding of religious beliefs and practices and how they affect people's lives. There will be an opportunity for you to consider religious and other means of reactions to issues such as sex before marriage; abortion; euthanasia.
- Religious studies should help you develop and mature as a person by encouraging you to investigate creeds, values and self-understanding.
- It will also broaden your understanding of other people and how they think.

How will I learn?

Learning is done through a variety of different methods, like teaching, discussion and visits to places of worship. You will develop reading and writing skills and share your learning with other students in classroom presentations and displays.

What will I need?

Resources will include books, the internet, TV and magazines.

How will I be assessed?

You will complete one examination paper of 2 hours covering Unit 1 at the end of Year 10 and a second examination of 2 hours covering Unit 2 at the end of Year 11.

What happens after this course?

After Year 11 you can choose to follow an AS and A Level Religious Studies course and continue to study RS for a university degree. Employers appreciate the wide range of skills developed by this course.

What will I learn?

The Land-Based Studies Level 1 qualification covers a wide range of units relating to land-based sector work such as horticulture or environmental management. The aim of the qualification is to provide practical based learning (knowledge and skills) which could allow progression to further learning or qualifications (such as a Level 2 Qualification in Land-based Studies) or into employment opportunities. You will also gain the Duke Edinburgh, and John Muir award whilst studying this qualification.

How will I learn?

Develop skills and understanding through units of work and practical land-based work.

What will I need?

Communicating Graphics is the process of creating visual material to convey information, ideas and emotions through the use of graphic elements such as colour, icons, images, typography and photographs, with a strong emphasis on elements produced digitally. This could include Advertising; Design for print e.g., posters, book/game covers, magazine design; Illustration; Interactive design / Multi-media; Package design; Signage and Typography.

What will I learn?

- Various visual presentation techniques
- To investigate visually in different ways.
- To understand how artists / graphic designers have responded to the same experiences, themes and problems as yourself.
- How to use industry standard digital design software (Adobe Creative Cloud)
- To work independently

How will I learn?

The course is dependent on you working independently to create a portfolio. The course has been broken up into structured activities, but it will be your responsibility to choose and select pieces for your coursework portfolio.

What will I need?

In addition to the resources available in school, it would be of an advantage for you to have your own personal collection of drawing materials for any homework set e.g., colouring pencils, paints, pencils of different 'hardness' (4B, 2B, HB, H, 2H).

How will I be assessed?

- Coursework portfolio which is worth 60% of the marks. Initial tasks will be based around upskilling you on the graphics software and will then progress onto larger more complex projects based upon given themes.
- Externally set exam worth 40%.

Themes for the exam will be received from the WJEC and after a period of research and preparation you will be given a 10-hour period to complete your final piece.

What happens after this course?

You could go on to study Communication Graphics at AS/A level at school.

You will be continuously assessed throughout the year. The course is shared into 4 units that are worth 25% each:

- Unit 1 - written exam comparing two poems
- Unit 2 - written exam based on the novel
- Unit 3 - oral exam discussing the film
- Unit 4 - two written controlled assessments based on a drama and short stories.

What will happen after the course?

Following Year 11, you can follow the AS and A Level course in Year 12 / 13.

You will choose a contextual challenge set by the examining board as a starting point for this task, and should use an iterative approach to design and make a prototype.

After Year 11, you can continue to study Product Design at A Level.

What will I need?

Through a combination of practical assessments, observation, coursework, written and oral tests.

What will I learn?

This course will help you learn:

- About the world around you by learning about materials, machines and living things.
- Science skills so that you can test ideas, complete experiments carefully and safely and then consider how correct and sensible the results are.

How will I learn?

A six lesson per week course that is taught in Year 10 that is split into Biology (Unit 1), Chemistry (Unit 2) and Physics (Unit 3). You will sit modular GCSE exams in June of Year 10 along with two practical assessments held January of Year 10. **Remember that the work and examinations in Year 10 contribute to your overall GCSE qualification.**

A 6 lesson per week course in Year 11. The Biology (Unit 4), Chemistry (Unit 5) and Physics (Unit 6) exams are at the end of Year 11. There will also be a Practical Assessment (Unit 7) that will be carried out in the School, but will be externally marked by WJEC. It will take place in the first half of the spring term (January – February).

What will I need?

You will be required to come to lessons with a complete set of writing instruments, a calculator and an A4 file in which to keep your work.

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed with examinations and practical work. There are three subjects, Biology (30%), Chemistry (30%) and Physics (30%). 10% of the marks are for practical assessments.

What happens after this course?

You will achieve 2 GCSE grades and, after completing these courses, you can follow Science A/S and A level courses in Years 12 / 13.

What will I learn?

This course will help you learn:

- About the world around you by learning about materials, machines and living things.
- To apply the knowledge, understanding and skills specified in a range of theoretical, practical, industrial and environmental contexts.
- Practical skills which will be fundamentally important to you if you intend to go on to further study in science and related subjects. These skills are transferable to many careers.

How will I learn?

A nine lesson per week course that is taught in Year 10 that is split into Biology (Unit 1), Chemistry (Unit 1) and Physics (Unit 1). You will sit modular GCSE exams in June of Year 10. There will also be three separate Practical Assessments (Biology Unit 3, Chemistry Unit 3 and Physics Unit 3) that will be carried out in School but will be externally marked by WJEC. They will take place in the first half of the spring term (January – February). **Remember that the work and examinations in Year 10 contribute to your overall GCSE qualification for each separate Science.**

A nine lesson per week course in Year 11. The Biology (Unit 2), Chemistry (Unit 2) and Physics (Unit 2) exams are at the end of Year 11.

What will I need?

You will be required to come to lessons with a complete set of writing instruments, a calculator and an A4 file in which to keep your work.

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed with examinations and practical work. These qualifications differ from the Double Science GCSE in that they are examined separately as three individual GCSEs. The three subjects are assessed in the same way:

Biology Unit 1, written 1 hour 45 minute examination (45% of the qualification).

Unit 2, written 1 hour 45 minute examination (45% of the qualification). Unit 3, Practical assessment (10% of the qualification).

Chemistry Unit 1, written 1 hour 45 minute examination (45% of the qualification). Unit 2, written 1 hour 45 minute examination (45% of the qualification). Unit 3, Practical assessment (10% of the qualification).

Physics Unit 1, written 1 hour 45 minute examination (45% of the qualification).

Unit 2, written 1 hour 45 minute examination (45% of the qualification). Unit 3, Practical assessment (10% of the qualification).

What happens after this course?

You will achieve 3 GCSE grades and, after completing these courses, you can follow Science A/S and A level courses in Years 12 / 13.

Students will be required to attend all lessons and bring with them any work in progress. You need basic writing equipment, as you would for all lessons. Regular attendance is imperative in order to complete all work.

How will I be assessed?

You will be continuously assessed. You will be expected to act upon targets of improvement to meet your expected grade targets. Of your total marks:

- 80% will be based on two examination papers which will test reading and writing skills.
- The remaining 20% will come from Speaking and Listening assignments, again to take place during lessons.

What happens after this course?

After Year 11, having gained a C grade or above, you will be able to choose English Language and Literature for AS and A Level.

Unit 2 introduces learners to a broad working knowledge of databases, spreadsheets, automated documents and images and enables learners to apply their knowledge and understanding to solve problems in vocational settings

Areas of Content:

- Planning, creating, modifying and using databases
- Planning, creating, modifying and using spreadsheets
- Planning, creating and modifying an automated document
- Planning, creating, manipulating and storing images

How will I be assessed?

Unit 1 – 1 hour 20 minute examination out of 80 marks which is worth 40% of the overall qualification.

Unit 2 – Non-examination assessment out of 120 marks which lasts 40 hours and is worth 60% of the overall qualification. An assignment brief will be provided by WJEC which will include a scenario and several tasks.

What will I need?

Interest in using computers and specialist software to create work of quality in response to the needs of modern requirements in the electronic age. Students must be conscientious and organised to ensure that all aspects of work is completed correctly.

The qualification is designed for learners who wish to begin their journey towards a career that utilises digital technologies or to progress onto advanced level programmes of learning involving digital technologies.

Why choose GCSE in Built Environment?

The WJEC GCSE in Built Environment offers a learning experience for 14 – 16 year olds which focuses on gaining and applying knowledge, skills and understanding through contextualised tasks and study. It provides an ideal introduction to the built environment.

What will I study?

Unit 1: Introduction to the Built Environment

In this examined unit you will develop knowledge, skills and understanding in the ideas and concepts related to the built environment. This will include the built environment life cycle, structures, materials, sustainability, careers and health & safety.

Unit 2: Creating the Built Environment

In this non-examined assessment unit (NEA) Designing the Built Environment the focus is on 2D and 3D drawing skills. The task in the NEA assesses your knowledge, understanding and skills in relation to identifying, interpreting and calculating information; writing success criteria; carrying out a range of techniques appropriate to the pathway and evaluating tasks.

Unit 3: Exploring the Built Environment

In this non-examined assessment unit (NEA) you will develop knowledge, skills and understanding in relation to the stages of the building life cycle; the stages and processes involved in the design, construction and value & use of the built environment.

How will I be assessed?

Unit 1: Introduction to the Built Environment will be assessed through a written examination.

- 1.5 hours
- 35% of the GCSE
- On-screen
- A range of questions based on ideas and concepts of the built environment

Unit 2: Creating the Built Environment will be assessed through non-examination assessment (NEA): marked by your teacher, externally moderated by WJEC.

- 25 hours
- 40% of the GCSE
- assessment will relate to either Constructing the Built Environment or Designing the Built Environment depending on your choice

Unit 3: Exploring the Built Environment will be assessed through non-examination assessment (NEA): marked by your teacher, externally moderated by WJEC.

- 15 hours
- 25% of the GCSE

Career Ideas

This GCSE provides you with a general overview of the built environment in addition to developing your abilities in a range of practical skills or design skills. It provides a potentially suitable foundation for further study, an apprenticeship or employment. It will also provide a coherent, satisfying and worthwhile course of study for you if you do not progress to further study in this subject. In addition, it will introduce you to many new aspects of the built environment which could help you make informed decisions about a wide range of career opportunities.

Architect, Architectural Technician, Buyer, Computer Aided Designer, Technician, Estimator, Site Inspector, Plant Technical Support, Site Engineer, Structural engineer, Quantity surveyor, Site manager, Electrical engineer, Mechanical engineer and many more.
